## **2. Bad debts recovery meeting held on 19th October 2015(Monday) at our Association Premises. Following points were suggested to Mr. A. Annamalai (Venkat) for bad debts recovery.**

1. MPMA to take up cases above a certain value only (may be 2 lakhs and above)
2. The member giving the complaint should submit his signed statement of account to MPMA to proceed further in this matter.
3. The member giving the complaint is to be present at all times in the recovery process.
4. The member to pay an upfront amount of 5% of the amount claimed.
5. Any additional expenses incurred in due course to be reimbursed by the complainant.
6. In the event of any excess amount available the same will be refunded.
7. The complaining member to pay 5% of the amount recovered to MPMA
8. If there are multiple members complaining against one defaulter, each of them will have to pay an upfront amount. The amount to be paid by each of the complaining member will be identified by committee
9. In such cases the amount recovered will be paid pro rate based on the outstanding.
10. MPMA will adopt all legal aspects to recover.
11. In case the complaining member does not pay further amounts, if any, after exhausting the upfront amount paid, MPMA will withdraw itself from proceeding. In such cases, the complaining member cannot claim only the unspent amount from the upfront payment.

Mr. Sekar Chandak suggested. If any customer will not pay the amount to the paper suppliers. All members will stop the business to the customer. Deposit amount Rs. 10,000/- it will be collect the party. Step -1- MPMA Members going to customer place. Step-2 Lawyer & Police Station.

Mr. Kasinathan Suggested. In Bad debts compliant, when we collect caution deposit from the complaint party, when the process not success we can refund to the party. Minimum amount fixed for complaint Rs. 1 lakh.

In this meeting we conclude Mr. A. Annamalai (Venkat) will finalized the format for bad debts recovery, it will be circulated to all members..
